How Do I Get My Passover Tickets?

Individuals must pick up their tickets, in person, at the Winnick Hillel Center for Jewish Life during business hours. Tickets will be available:

Friday, March 5, 10:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. (Buy them before Shabbat!)

Monday, March 8 - Friday, March 12, 10:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Monday, March 22 - Friday, March 26, 10:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Please remember to have your valid student ID with you.

How Many Tickets Can I Get?

Each student that presents a valid student ID may receive only one (1) ticket. All Syracuse / ESF faculty and staff may receive two (2) tickets.

What Kind of Seder Is It?

Hillel uses its own Haggadah every year. It caters to everyone, regardless of your background. Our Seders are fun, student-led, and very interactive. We promise that you will have a great time.

When is Passover?

Passover begins at sundown on Monday, March 29, and concludes at sundown on Tuesday, April 6.

Meals Served All Week Long

In addition to the Seder offerings on the previous page, Kosher for Passover lunches and dinners will be provided throughout the holiday at the Winnick Hillel Center for Jewish Life. We are located, conveniently, at 102 Walnut Place. It's just a short walk from campus. Lunch is served from 11:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Dinner is served from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Meals can be deducted from your meal plan with a swipe of your student ID. Not on a meal plan? Lunch is \$11.00 and dinner is \$16.00. Cash, credit (Visa, MC, Amex, Discover), checks, and SUpercard are accepted.
